
STEP 1 (requires left and right to be made)

Using your tray

To lock transmitter into place, first loosen knob and slide clip over handle of the transmitter (Fig. 1 below). The clip has a guide pin to assist in keeping the clip straight as you slide it. The clip can also be reversed to accommodate different transmitter positions. The side of the clip with the foam strip should tighten down over the transmitter handle. Do not over tighten as this can cause damage to transmitters with plastic handles. If the stud on the knob is not long enough to allow your handle to slide under the clip, a cut off bolt can be replaced with the installed one. A small amount of blue lock tight can be used to secure it to the knobs threaded insert.


